TUI Austria	TUI Austria continues to operate to Madeira, Naples, Sardinia (OLB, CAG), Sicily (CTA), Kefalonia, Crete (HER & CHQ), Karpathos (AOK), Prevesa, Zakynthos, Corfu, Rhodes, Skiathos, Santorini, Thessaloniki, Araxos, Kos, & Cyprus (LCA), as well as Majorca, Ibiza, the Canary Islands, Turkey (AYT, DLM, BJV), Egypt (HRG), Mexico (CUN) the United Arab Emirates (DXB), Dominican Republic (PUJ), and the Maldives.

TUI France

TUI France continues to operate to Club Lookea and Club Marmara in the following destinations: Kos, Corfu, Crete, Athens, Sicily, Sardinia, Spain (Andalucia), Majorca, Fuerteventura, Lanzarote, Bulgaria, Croatia and Portugal, Zanzibar & the Dominican Republic .

UK Government Traffic Light System

Customers from the UK are able to travel overseas on holiday following a traffic light system introduced by the UK Government with Green, Amber and Red destinations. TUI will only fly to destinations on the Green and Amber list and where the Foreign Commonwealth and Development Office travel advice allows. TUI will not operate to Red listed countries.

Amber listed Countries:

From **04.00hrs on Monday 19 July**, residents of England arriving from an Amber destination who have been double vaccinated by the UK National Health Service (NHS) and 14 days have passed since their second vaccination, will no longer need to self-isolate or take a Day 8 test when returning home from an Amber country.

Children aged between 5 and 17 who are travelling with a fully vaccinated adult will only need to take a day 2 test and be exempt from self-isolation. Children aged 4 and under will be exempt from all testing and self-isolation requirements.

This update is for **England only** and we await information for Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Adults over 18 returning from Amber destinations to England after **04.00hrs on Monday 19 July** who are not double vaccinated will still need to self-isolate and follow Amber testing requirements.

The following measures will also remain in place:

- Travellers must take a covid-19 test before travel
- Travellers must pay for a covid-19 test on day 2 after arrival in England..
- **Until 19 July**, current rules will still apply i.e on arrival in England travellers must:
 - quarantine at home or in the place you are staying for 10 days
 - take a COVID-19 test on or before day 2 and on or after day 8

Green listed countries

Green entry requirements will still apply - the Antigen test before flying home and the Day 2 PCR test after returning will still be required.
